COURSES

Chandigarh College of Pharmacy continued its tradition of imparting quality pharmaceutical education through seven academic programmes comprising **Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm), Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D), Doctor of Pharmacy (Post Baccalaureate), M.Pharm (Pharmaceutics), M.Pharm (Pharmacology), M.Pharm (Pharmacy Practice), and M.Pharm (Regulatory Affairs)**. The curriculum was complemented by practical training, research activities, industry interaction, and experiential learning to prepare competent pharmacy professionals.

RANKINGS

The institution continued to receive recognition for its commitment to excellence in pharmacy education. During the academic session 2021–22, Chandigarh College of Pharmacy secured the **91st Rank in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF)** under the Pharmacy category. The college also received the prestigious **APAC Education Leadership Award**, acknowledging its contribution to quality education and institutional excellence.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

Academic excellence remained the primary focus of the institution. Through student-centric teaching methodologies, continuous assessment, and academic mentoring, the college achieved an impressive **overall university result of 97%**. The institution maintained consistently high academic standards, although no university merit positions were secured during the session.

International Achievements

Students actively represented the institution at international platforms. **Harshpreet**, B.Pharm Semester IV, received the **Best Delegate Award** at the **International Model United Nations (IMUN) Conference**, demonstrating exceptional communication, analytical and leadership skills.

Students participated successfully in several national-level academic competitions. **Harshpreet** secured **First Position in the War of Words Competition** organized by the Global Council,

Haryana, achieved **All India Rank 57** in the S7 Poetry Competition, and received a Participation Award from the Flaming Pen Association. Mr. Archit, Mr. Ansh and Ms. Bhavya secured **Third Position** in the Poster Presentation Competition during the National Conference on Pharmacovigilance and Clinical Research organized at CGC Landran.

Mr. Deepak (Pharm.D Third Year) won **Bronze Medal in the 200 m Race, Silver Medal in the 100 m Race, and Silver Medal in Athletics** organized by DSW, CGC Landran. Cultural Achievements

During the period, faculty members published **30 research papers**, authored **7 books/book chapters**, and secured **4 patents**, reflecting the institution's commitment to research and innovation.

The college maintained active collaborations with pharmaceutical industries, hospitals and healthcare organizations through industrial visits, expert lectures, internships and training programmes to bridge the gap between academia and industry.
