Academic Session: July 2022 – June 2023

COURSES

During the academic session 2022–23, Chandigarh College of Pharmacy offered **six academic programmes**, namely B.Pharm, Pharm.D and four M.Pharm specializations in Pharmaceutics, Pharmacology, Pharmacy Practice and Regulatory Affairs. The programmes emphasized academic excellence, clinical exposure, research, innovation and professional ethics.

RANKINGS

Students continued to perform exceptionally in cultural activities by securing **First Position in the Women Empowerment Dance Competition, Second Position in Navtarang, Second Position in Dance Competition during Parivartan 2K23, and First Prize in Dance Competition organized on World Heart Day**, highlighting their artistic excellence.

Research activities expanded considerably during the session.
