The library works on **LIBSYS software**. The library has **2 CCTV cameras** to keep a close watch on the users to minimize the losses and mutilation of reading material. Our college library is an institution within the institution. The young minds are exposed to ever-expanding fields of knowledge that lie dormant in books and journals. An endeavor is to make them library-minded. Ours is a functional, well-equipped, and fully computerized library having a proud collection of **13749 books** on its open shelves. In addition to this collection, the library also subscribes to E-Resources including e-books and e-journals. CCP Library has **1862 Reference and General reading books**, and **3060 foreign author books**. The library has a total **252.43 sqm** area with a sitting capacity of more than **100** seats. The library currently has **1300 members**. The library is subscribing to **8 magazines, 10 newspapers, and 15 print national and international journals**. The library has DELNET membership and EBSCO database for e-resources. The library has the latest pharmacopeias 2022 edition.



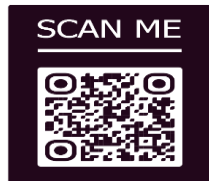

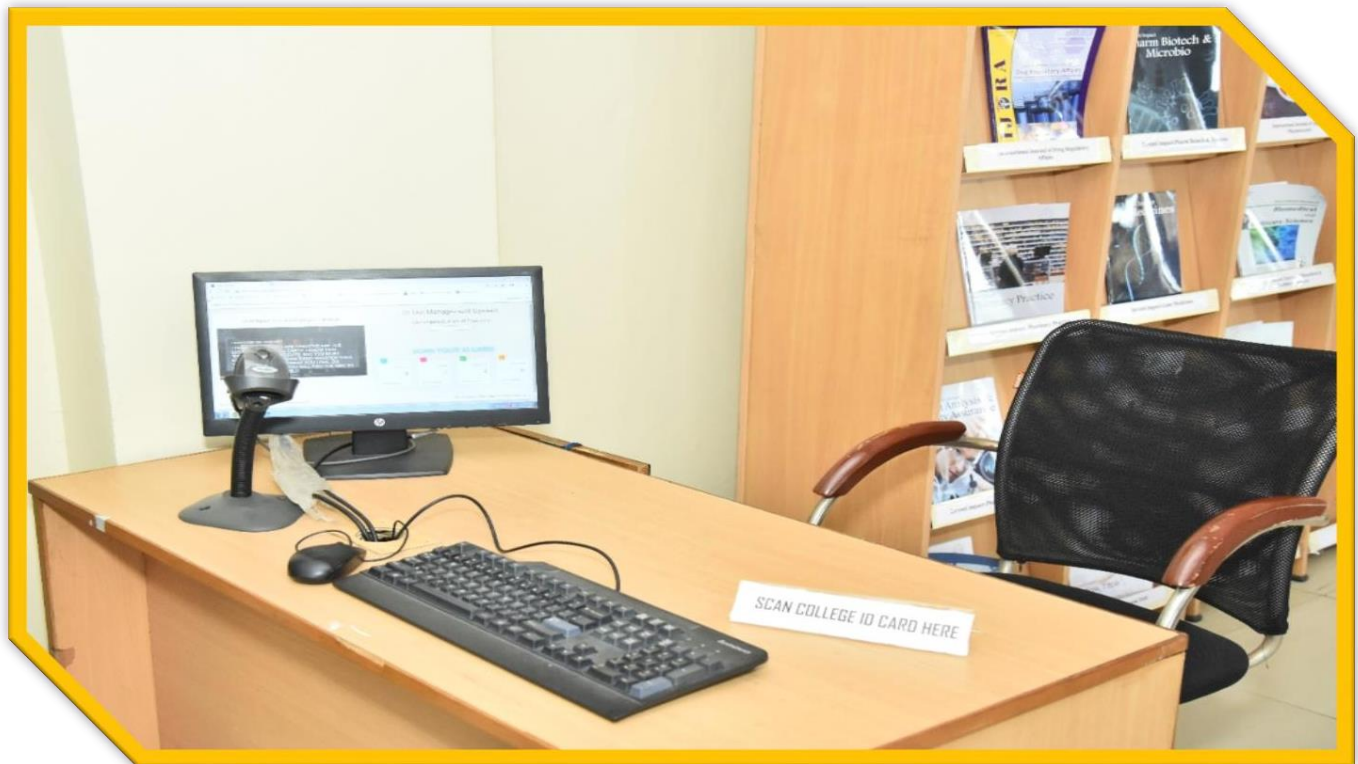

**BARCODE SCANNED ENTRY/EXIT:** Since the ID cards are scanned to keep track of entry and exit, foot traffic in the library is computerized. Students scan their ID cards as they enter or leave the library using the two barcode scanners that have been installed on the ENTRY/EXIT gate.

**STEP 4 : SELECT THE BOOK OF YOUR CHOICE FROM YOUR CONCERNED LIBRARY ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE FIELD (i.e., ALL) AND "GO".**

**STEP 5 : SELECT BROWSE :** TO KNOW ABOUT COLLECTION BY AUTHOR , TITLE, CLASSIFIED, SUBJECT, PUBLISHER, PLACE.

**STEP 6 : SELECT MY ACCOUNT : TO KNOW ABOUT THE BOOKS YOU HAVE**

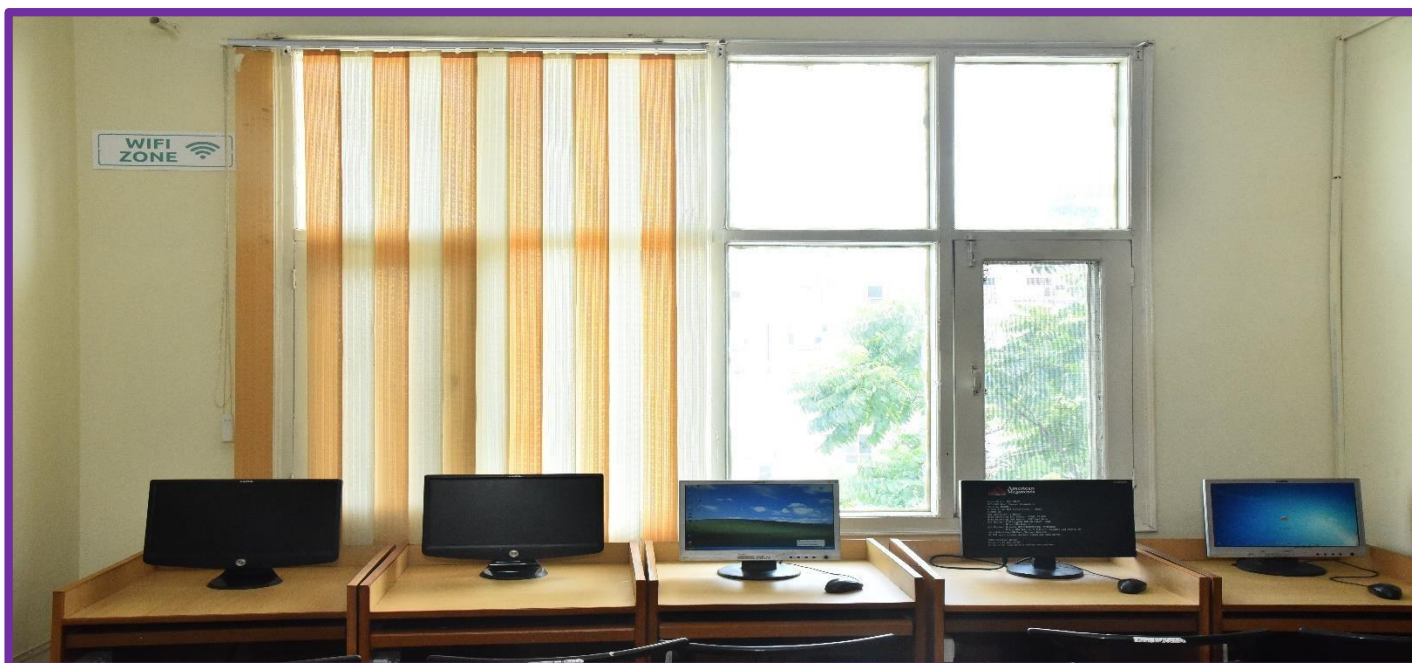



# ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

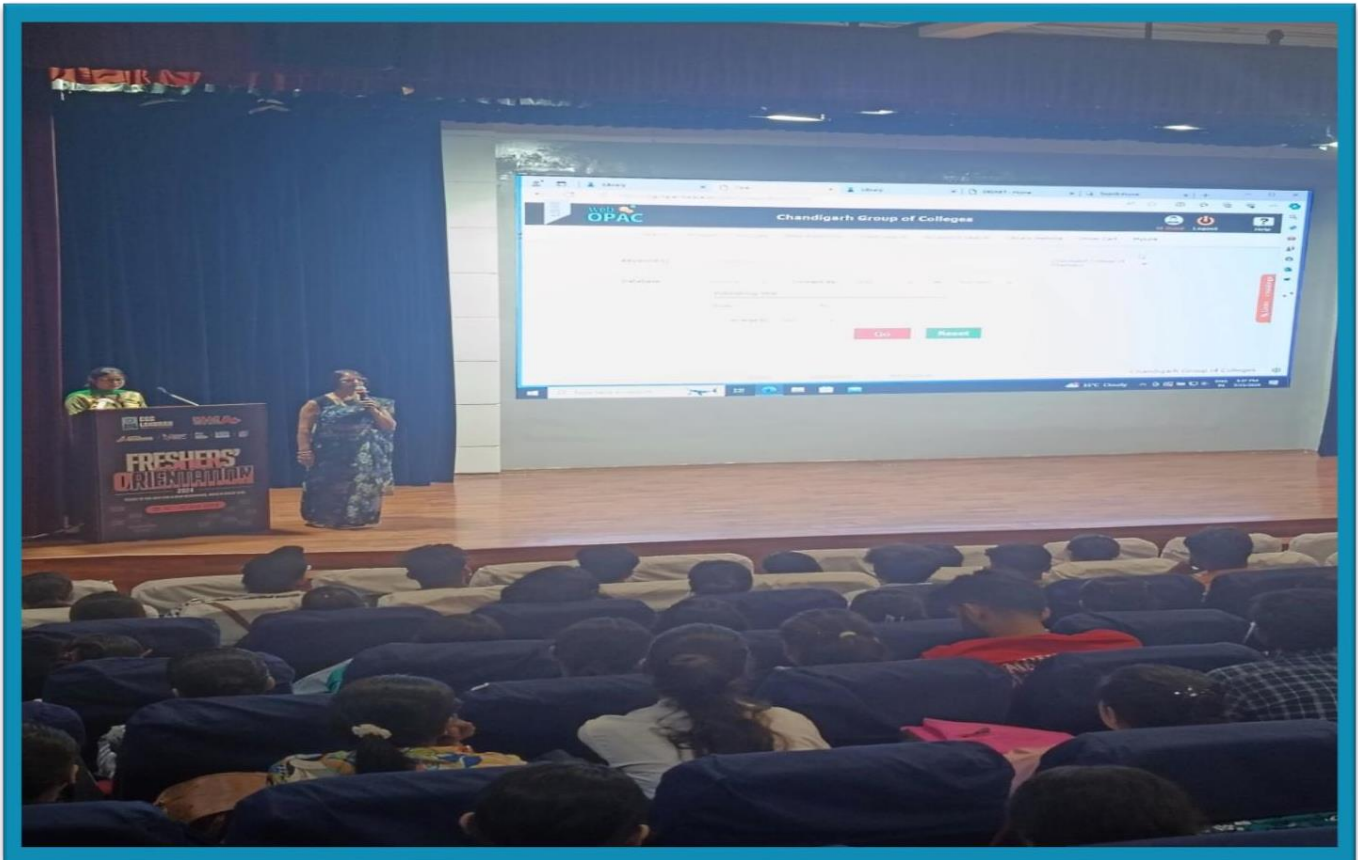
## SESSION 2022-2023

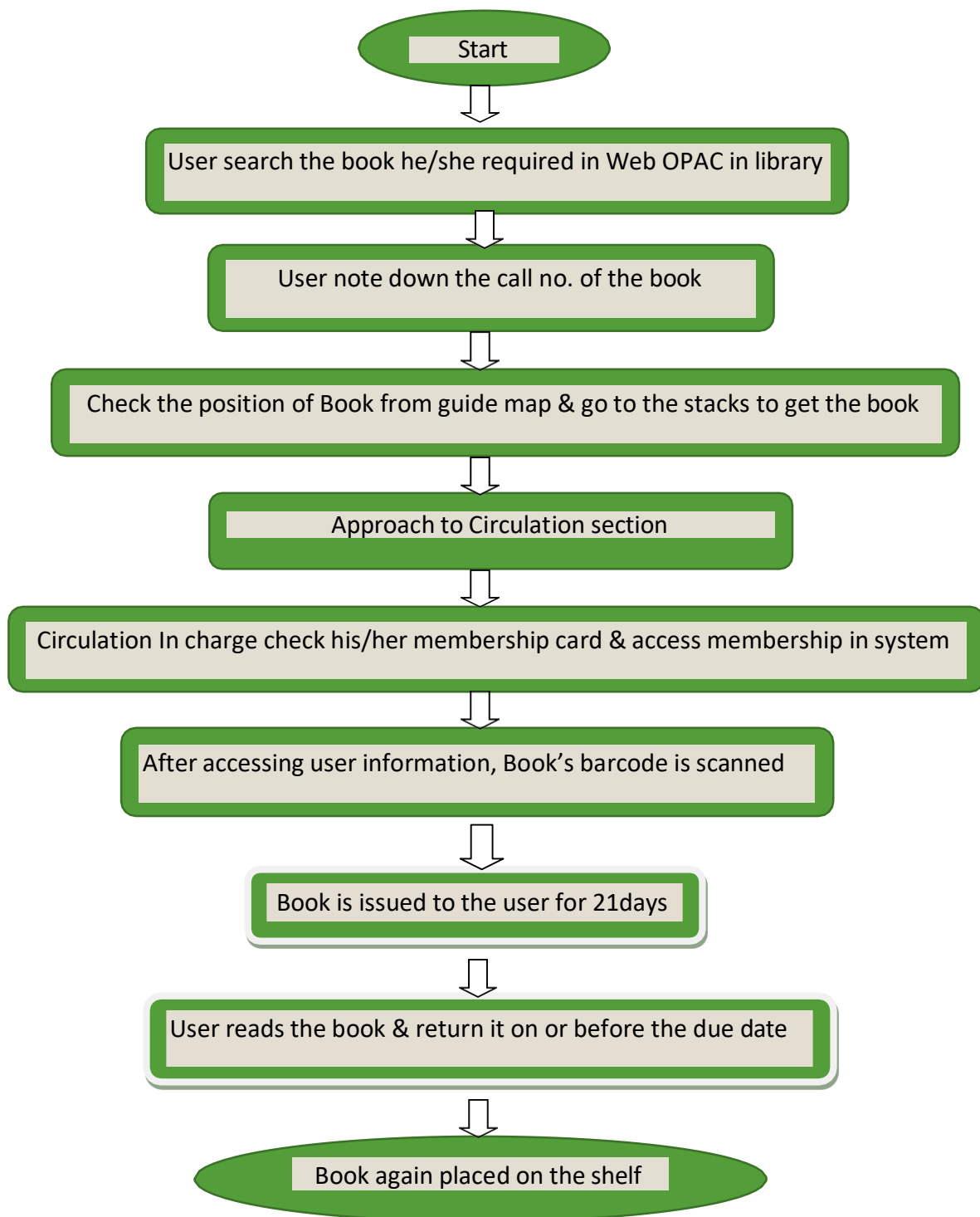

- ✓ Reference Books and Magazines are available for consultation only in the Library.
- ✓ Loss of the book should be immediately reported to the librarian and the matter settled by replacing the book or paying its prices within a week of due date. Delay fine, however, will be charged up to the date the matter is settled.
- ✓ The damage, if any, to a book should be brought to the notice of the librarian before getting the books issued, otherwise the person returning it will be held responsible for the damage.
- ✓ The student will be responsible for any loss which the library may suffer due to loss or misuse of the library/Id card.
- ✓ After reading, leave books on the table. Please do not shelve the books.
- ✓ Ask for help from library staff if you are unable to find your required material
