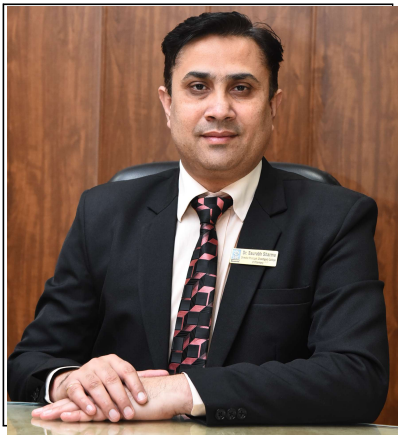

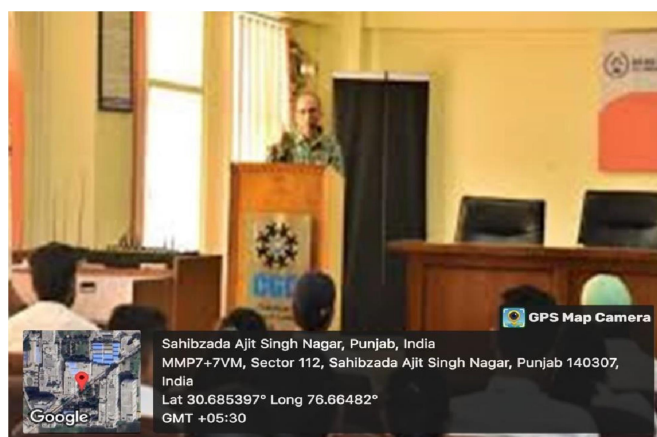
Medication Safety Matters: Pharmacy Awareness Program for Safe & Effective Use of Medicines
