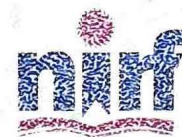

Celebration of World Pharmacist Day-2025

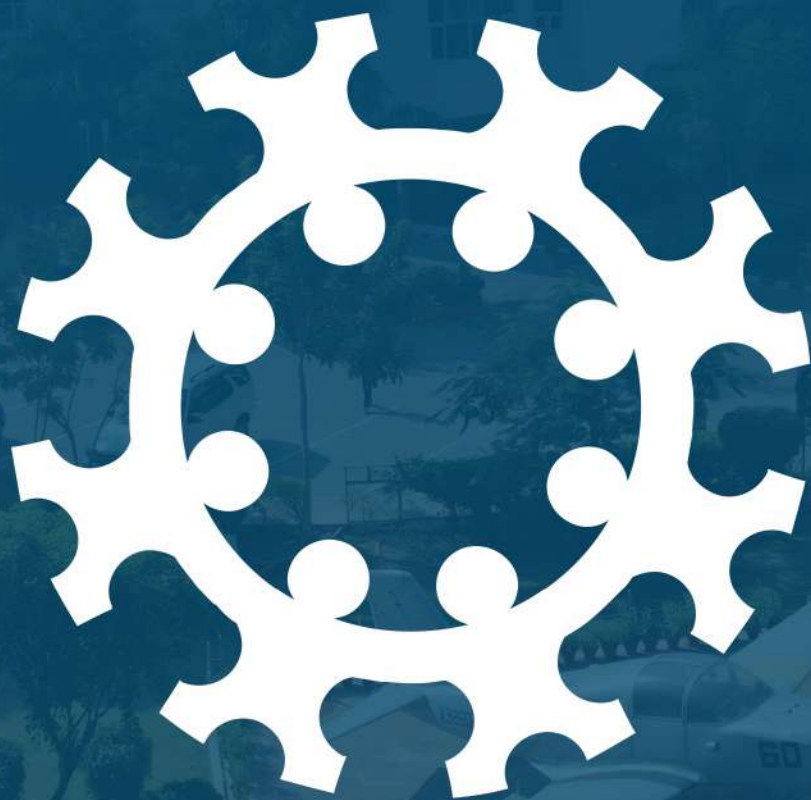
