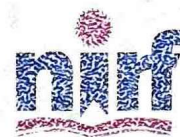

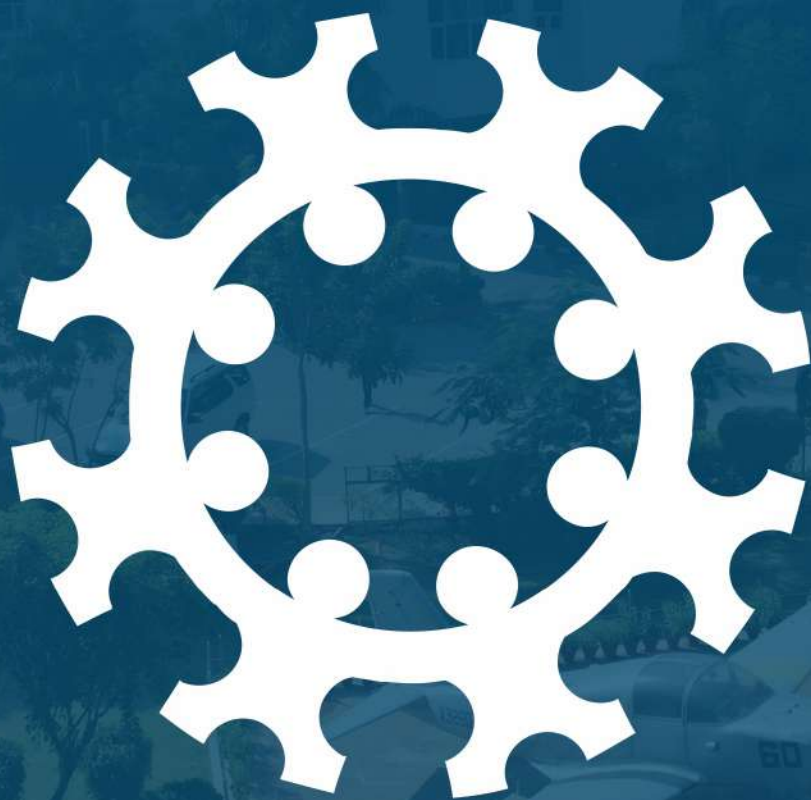
Memorandum of Understanding between Chandigarh College of Pharmacy and Bioatoms Incorporation Mohali, Punjab
